Pat told us more about the hardships she has overcome to get where she is now, and the passion and care she puts into every element of



her shop Aeternum, which originates from the Latin word, eternal.

Q: Please tell us about your jewellery collections.

A: We've got about 40 different jewellery collections, we started with the amber jewellery because my father was Polish, and I wanted to bring a bit of Poland to Scotland.

Everything's handmade that we sell in here, weather it be jewellery or handcrafts.

I go and meet all the artists regularly, and I know them all.

We have artists from 10 different countries from all over the world in Aeternum.

Q: What's happening at Aeternum during the festive season?

A: We have a 20 per cent sale all this month on all of our jewellery, which is quite a saving - especially on our more expensive pieces!

We've had lots of new

They are made by a family firm in Greece, and what I loved about it was they included olive wood in the design, I'm quite excited about

We've also got a collection of Italian silk scarves coming in the new year, which will be a collection made just for us, and it's going to be based on Scottish flower colours.

I had no experience in it, but I just loved helping people.

Unfortunately, because I didn't get any funding from any government bodies, I took my eve off the business. and I ended up bankrupt. I was homeless for about eight months.

It has been hard. I've never given up, just keep going.

Q: Who are your Inverness city centre stars?

A: The Mustard Seed for eating, my sister and I go in there regularly - we love it. Maggie Blyth has got some really beautiful clothes, Hastie and Dyce the butchers are very popular, and do very tasty steaks pies - one of my favourites!
